Dear Mr. Fellner,

Recently, a friend of mine sent me a few pages from a book, which contained a moving chapter by you: "Bittere Heimatgeschichte, das Schicksal der juedischen Zwangsarbeiter in Krottendorf and Kalch." In this chapter you mentioned that the remains of seven people who died in a labor camp in Neuhaus were removed to a Jewish cemetery in Rechnitz. One of those seven was my father, Sandor Braun. In 1961, my family and I visited Neuhaus and we had a gravestone made to mark where he was buried.

I returned to Neuhaus in 1995 and was very disappointed to find no sign of the gravestone. From your book I learned that the graves were moved in 1988 by the Jewish Community in Vienna.

The mason who made the gravestone was Herbert Mund. We corresponded with the Mund family in the 1960s. We were also in touch with Mr. and Mrs. Johann Mautner at the same time.

We lost contact with the two families and would be grateful if you could give us information about them. If the Munds or Mautners are deceased, perhaps you might be able to give us information about their children.

Thank you for your help in this matter.
